- 4) Involved in consistent fellowship with other believers through a local church.
- 5) Adhere to Plus One Guidance Center “Statement of Faith,” “Faith in Practice Statement,” and “Statement of Principle.”
- 6) Share the passion for Plus One Guidance Center’s mission:
 - The ultimate goal of Plus One Guidance Center is to impact generations of families forever. We do this by assisting women and couples facing unplanned pregnancies in making the healthiest choices possible for themselves and their unborn children. In assisting our clients, we work to meet their immediate needs for guidance as well as meet their ultimate need for connection to our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

Faith in Practice Statement

Faith in Christ is reflected in the lives of Plus One Guidance Center board members, volunteers, and staff in the following ways:

Plus One Guidance Center is a Christ-centered pregnancy help center and certain behaviors and activities are unacceptable and incompatible with the mission and vision of Plus One Guidance Center. All board members, volunteers, and staff must be actively participating in a local family of faith. Individuals should be displaying the fruit of the Spirit in their relationships with one another (Galatians 5:22-23). Additionally, because Plus One Guidance Center focuses on sexual integrity, all board members, volunteers, and staff must practice sexual integrity in their relationships. Sex outside of marriage, living with a significant other outside of marriage, or homosexual behavior is incompatible with the mission and vision of Plus One Guidance Center. In other words, Plus One Guidance Center board members, staff, and volunteers submit to the teaching of Scripture that God’s design for sexual intimacy places it within the context of marriage between one man and one woman, and acknowledge that the practice of homosexuality is incompatible with Biblical teaching.

Plus One Guidance Center Statement of Faith

1. We believe in God the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth.

And we believe that the only way for anyone to be forgiven of their sins and to have eternal life is through personal faith in Jesus Christ, who is God and who came from God (John 1:1-3), who became a human being like us and who lived a perfect, sinless life (Hebrews 4:15), and who willingly died on the cross the death we deserved in our place for our sin as the only sufficient payment for sin (Isaiah 53:1-6, Mark 10:45, John 1:29, John 6:51; Romans 3:23-26, 5:8, 6:23a), and who, having paid for the sins of all humanity for all time (Hebrews 7:27, 9:12; 1 Peter 3:18; 1 John 2:2), rose from the grave on the third day from his death, proving His victory over sin and death and His authority and power to make people right with God and to make them children and friends of God forever from the very moment they repent and place their trust in Jesus alone (John 1:12, John 3:16-18, Acts 3:19; 4:12; Romans 6:23b, 10:9-10, 13; 1 Corinthians 15).

We affirm that the testimony given to us in the Bible is the word of God, given by the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, who carried along the human writers of Scripture as they wrote down the messages contained in these books (2 Peter 1:20-21). Therefore, since these Scriptures come from God, they are completely trustworthy. The Bible is God's message to us about who He is, who we are, what He has done for us, and how to follow Him and live out His purpose for our lives (2 Timothy 3:16-17). That purpose is to have a friendship with God forever and to demonstrate how good and how great He is in the way we live now because of His friendship with us and Presence in us.

We believe that the only sin that can keep anyone from God is the sin of not believing on Jesus, (John 3:16-18, 2 Corinthians 5:19-6:1). No matter what evil we have done, and no matter what evil has been done to us, God's grace toward us in Jesus Christ and God's life in us by the Holy Spirit give us the righteous standing before God and the divine power we need to live new and truly good lives in service to Him as the new creations He makes us (Romans 6:4, Galatians 2:20, Ephesians 2:8-10, Titus 2:11-14). Plus One Guidance Center Statement of Principle:

- 1) Plus One Guidance Center is an outreach ministry of Jesus Christ through His Church. Therefore, Plus One Guidance Center, embodied in its volunteers, is committed to presenting the good news of our Lord, both in word and deed, to women and couples with crisis pregnancies, as well as both men and women suffering from the after-effects of abortion. In keeping with this purpose, those who labor as Plus One Guidance Center board members, directors, and volunteers are expected to know Christ as their Savior and Lord.
- 2) Plus One Guidance Center is committed to providing its clients with accurate and complete information about both prenatal development and abortion.
- 3) Plus One Guidance Center is committed to integrity in dealing with clients, earning their trust, providing promised information and services and eschewing any form of deception in its corporate advertising or individual conversations.
- 4) Plus One Guidance Center is committed to assisting women to carry to term by providing emotional support and practical assistance. Through the provision of God's people and the community at large, women may face the future with hope and plan constructively for themselves and their babies.
- 5) Plus One Guidance Center never discriminates in providing services because of race, creed, color, national origin, age, or marital status of its clients.
- 6) Plus One Guidance Center never advises, provides, or refers for abortion or abortifacients.
- 7) Plus One Guidance Center offers assistance free of charge at all times.
- 8) Plus One Guidance Center is committed to creating awareness within the local community of the needs of pregnant women and of the fact that abortion only compounds human need rather than resolving it.
- 9) Plus One Guidance Center does not refer single women for contraceptives. The value of sexual integrity will be emphasized with single clients when discussing the topic of birth control. Health issues relevant to various forms of birth control may be addressed with single and married clients. When a married client requests contraceptive services, she will be referred to a physician.
- 10) Plus One Guidance Center recognizes the validity of adoption as one alternative to abortion, but is not biased toward adoption when compared with other life-saving alternatives. Plus One Guidance Center is independent of adoption agencies, relating to them in the same manner as to other helpful referral sources. Plus One Guidance Center receives no payments of any kind from these agencies, does not enter into contractual relationships with them, and does not share office space with them. Adoption agencies are not established under the auspices of Plus One Guidance Center. Plus One Guidance Center neither initiates nor facilitates independent adoption.
